As a young organization, Minwashin wishes to anchor its development and actions on the territory in which he takes part, the Anishinabe AKI. Acting in the field of Anishinabe arts and culture, we aim for consistency and securing our vision to the cultural realities and to the specific needs of the Anishinabek.

Minwashin is looking for a project manager for the artistic and cultural development to join its team. Under the director general supervision, the project manager will specifically coordinate the Papakinece - Étincelle project. This project consists in the development of innovative ways to equip and attract Anishinabek artists and cultural bearers to bring them toward the professionalization of their art. The project manager for cultural and artistic development will get around the whole Anishinabe territory to meet with the artists and cultural bearers.

Job description

- Coordinate the different project phases;
- Make interviews with the artists and write a synthesis;
- Organize training courses;
- Reach the next generation of Anishinabek artists;
- Encourage the establishment of a community of practice;
- Give tools to emerging artists for them to be involved in a professionalization process;
- Accompany artists in their practice development;
- Host the meetings with the artists and cultural bearers.
